I represent Treshawn Markeese Jenkins in the above referenced matter. On June 20, 2019, I filed a brief pursuant to Anders v. California, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), in his case. With his permission, I am writing on Mr. Jenkins' behalf to request an additional extension of time for him to file his brief. I spoke to Mr. Jenkins by phone today. He informed me that he wishes to file a *pro se* brief in response to my Anders brief. He requested an extension of time in August, and this Court graciously granted him more time.
