Dear Mr. Deloach:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$250.00.
- A proof of service to the respondents' counsel has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The notice of appeal is not in the correct format. Pursuant to Rule 203, SCACR the following information must be included in the notice and no other information shall be included: the name of the court, judge, and county from which the appeal is taken; the docket number of the case in the lower court; the date of the order, judgment, or sentence from which the appeal is taken; a statement of when the appealing party received notice of the order

or judgment from which the appeal is taken; the name of the party taking the appeal; and the names and mailing addresses of all attorneys or record and the names of the party or parties represented by each. The notice of appeal that was filed was a template for the Court of Common Pleas, not for the Court of Appeals. A notice of appeal must be in the format shown in Form 1 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
