
ORDER

On December 2, 2019, an order of dismissal was filed in this post-conviction relief case. The public case index for Georgetown County indicates that on December 12, 2019, a motion under Rule 59 of the South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure was filed by petitioner's counsel seeking to alter or amend the dismissal order. It further appears that no order has been filed resolving this motion. On January 3, 2020, this Court received a *pro se* notice of appeal from petitioner seeking review of the dismissal order.

The *pro se* notice of appeal is dismissed without prejudice pursuant to *Hudson v. Hudson*, 290 S.C. 215, 349 S.E.2d 341 (1986). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
