**MOTION FOR THIRD EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
INITIAL BRIEF OF RESPONDENT AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER**

Respondent, the State, moves this Court for an additional thirty (30) day extension of time in which to file the Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation of Matter, which is currently due to be filed Friday, January 17, 2010. Undersigned counsel has been scheduled to complete a number of state and federal matters within the past 30 days that include, but are not limited to, the following: the filing of the complete state court record in the capital federal habeas corpus matter of Stephen Stanko vs. Stirling, et al., C/A No. 1:19-03257-RMG-SVH (December 19, 2019); the Return and Memorandum of Law in Support of Motion for Summary Judgment in the matter of Melinda

Richmond vs. Patricia Yeldell, Warden, C/A No. 0:19-2689-BHH-PJG, also pending the United States District Court for the District of South Carolina (December 23, 2019); the Reply to Petitioner's Response in Opposition to the Return and Memorandum in Support of Summary Judgment in the capital federal habeas corpus matter of Quincy J. Allen, #6019 vs. Willie D. Davis, Warden, C/A No. 0:18-1544-DCC-PJG (December 30, 2019), and Respondent's Motion to Strike in that same case (January 7, 2020); and the Response in Opposition to Applicant's Motion to Alter or Amend in the non-capital post-conviction relief matter of Gonzales Reese Wardlaw vs. State of South Carolina, 2015-CP-32-02990, pending in the South Carolina Court of Common Pleas for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit (January 2, 2020).

Due to counsel's involvement in these and other matters in state and federal court, counsel has begun, but is unable to complete, the Initial Brief of Respondent in this action prior to the due date prescribed. This request is made in good faith, and not for the purposes of delay. Thus, counsel respectfully requests a thirty (30) day extension of time to allow counsel to complete the Initial Brief of Respondent. This is counsel's third request for additional time to do so.
