You're concerning these two motions as being appealed and the remittitur sent under Appellate Case number 2017-001863... in which is impossible because the remittitur was sent 2 years early before the two motion

I'm talking about that I sought to appeal in 2019, your concerning as already been ruled upon by S.C. Court of Appeals under Appellate

Case # 2017-001863-1. How can you even make such a Big error  
in your judgment concerning this case? Then attempt to deny me access  
to the S.C. Court of Appeals and kept my documents and tell me no other  
action will be taken? Appellate Case 2017-001863 is dealing with the  
appeal of a Motion to Vacate ~~and~~ sentence already served. Not the  
Motion for a new trial pursuant to Brady violation Brady v Maryland 373-US 83  
1963 dated 1-24-2019 filed with the office of the clerk of Court of  
General Sessions Court Paul B Wickensimmer, Clerk. on Feb 5<sup>th</sup> 2019

The other Motion to set aside the judgment of SC Supreme Court
