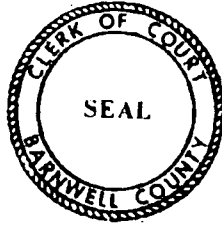
Criminal Sexual Conduct charge in 1996



Notice of Intent to Seek Life Without Parole
for a Burglary 2nd Violent
(Oct. 17, 2007) *EM*

The State of South Carolina hereby notifies Maurice Anthony Odom of intent to seek sentencing under Section 17-25-45 (Life Sentence for Person Convicted of Certain Crimes) of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended. The Defendant, Maurice Anthony Odom currently faces a charge of Burglary 2nd (violent), "a serious offense." The State hereby provides notice to the Defendant that should he be convicted of Burglary 2nd (violent) he must be sentenced to a term of imprisonment for life without the possibility of parole pursuant to Section 17-25-45 (B). The State of South Carolina relies on the Defendant Maurice Anthony Odom's previous convictions for Criminal Sexual Conduct with a minor, 2nd degree, a "most serious offense", in 2002, and Burglary 2nd (violent), "a serious offense", in 1997.

This notice serves as written notice from the Solicitor to Defendant and Defendant's Counsel pursuant to the terms of Section 17-25-45 (H).
