¹ The notice of appeal also references the denial of post-conviction relief in 2010-CP-31-00082 and 2010-CP-31-00158. These two cases were merged into 2010-CP-31-00082, and the appeal from the final order in 2010-CP-31-00082 has already been concluded by order dated May 3, 2012. *Collins v. State*, Appellate Case No. 2012-207558. There is simply no authority which allows petitioner to have a second appellate review regarding these merged cases.
