Dear Mr. Scott

Upon reviewing your amended appellant's initial brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The document is improperly paginated. Specifically, each page shall be consecutively numbered.
- The initial brief is not accompanied by a designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal. The document that you submitted is being returned to you. This document needs to only be listed in the designation of matter and included in the record on appeal.
- The caption on the cover page does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the caption shall contain the name of the appellate court where the document is to be filed, the name of the tribunal from which the appeal is taken, the name of the administrative judge, the case number of the Administrative Law Court and/or the Court of Appeals, the title of the document, and the name and address of the counsel submitting the document. No other information shall be on the cover page.

This is the Court's second request for these corrections. Your appeal will be dismissed if these corrections are not made.
