COUNT TWO- CARJACKING

That **DIANTE JAQUAN ROGERS** did in Florence County on or about the August 28, 2017, with others take and/or attempt to take one SILVER IMPALA from Katherine Wilson by force and violence or by intimidation while said victim was operating and/or in the vehicle, by using their vehicle and hemmed in and blocked Katherine Wilsons vehicle at the intersection of Byrd and Kershaw Street, and attempted to take her car causing great bodily injury to the victim, in violation of Section 16-3-1075(B)(2), S.
