On December 4, 2019, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Brandon James Littell v. The State with the Supreme Court. On November 25, 2019, counsel filed a petition for a writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in The State v. Anthony M. Enriquez with the Supreme Court.


3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will

hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


4. As indicated by the counsel below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.
