Dear Mrs. Kitchings:

I represent the Appellee Innovative Waste management ("IWM"). This appeal was administratively dismissed on November 21, 2019 and it is currently dismissed. Appellant ("Crest") filed a Motion to Reinstate the appeal and IWM filed a return to that motion. Crest did not file a response to IWM's return nor has it filed any supplemental briefing or authority. The Motion to Reinstate is pending.

On December 20, 2019 and again on January 22, 2020 Mr. Marvel wrote to the Court on behalf of Crest. In both letters Mr. Marvel referenced Crest's pending Motion for Reinstatement and offered substantive arguments and facts specifically related to Crest's failure to order the transcripts in this matter and the issue of the prejudice that has been suffered by IWM. Mr. Marvel's communications appear to be an attempt to interject supplemental briefing, and to that extent, we respectfully request that any such communications be disregarded by the Court in the determination of the pending motion.

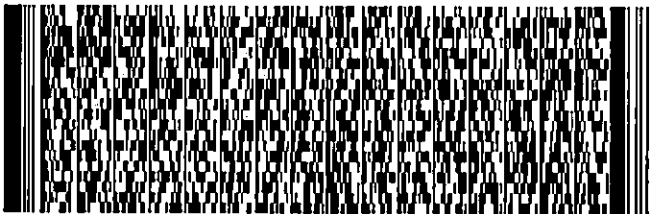

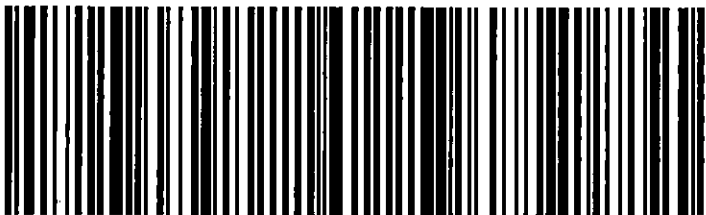
