ORDER


Petitioner has filed a petition for a writ of certiorari seeking review of the decision of the South Carolina Court of Appeals in Appellate Case Number 2016-001627. He has also filed a request for an extension to assemble the "record" in this case.¹

As to the extension request, petitioner has failed to pay the motion filing fee required by Rule 240(d) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), or to file a request seeking a waiver of that fee. Accordingly, no action will be taken on the request for an extension.

The petition for a writ of certiorari fails to have the content required by Rule 242(d), SCACR. Further, petitioner has failed to pay the filing fee required by Rule 242(c), SCACR, or to serve and file a motion seeking a waiver of that fee. Accordingly, this appellate case is dismissed.
