


Dear Mr. Getter:



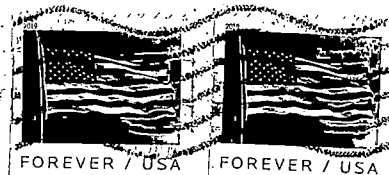
