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authority information to their insured Receiver, even after this Court ordered the Insurers to provide the information by September 30, 2019. As such, this Court hereby ORDERS Covil's Insurers—USF&G, Sentry, Zurich, and Hartford—to show cause why they should not be held in contempt of Court for violation of this Court's Order Appointing a Receiver for Covil Corporation; Order Compelling their Attendance at Mediation; and Order for a Rule to Show Cause. Further, the Insurers must be prepared to discuss by policy and annual period or portion thereof the original and remaining limits of Covil's insurance policies under all applicable coverage parts, including separately as to the product liability/completed operations coverage part and the operations/premises coverage part and to provide an accounting of the amounts paid in settlement for each claim paid or settled, who authorized payment, under what coverage parts of the policies settlements or judgments were paid, documentation or other evidence supporting the analysis and characterization of claims as products/completed operations or operations/premises claims, method of allocation of settlements or judgments paid among Insurers, policies and policy years and if no payment was made because of a denial of coverage, the stated basis at the time of settlement for such denial.

A hearing on this matter will be scheduled for November 13, 2019 and USF&G, Sentry, Zurich, and Hartford are required to attend.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Zurich American Insurance Company; Sentry Insurance, A Mutual Company; United States Fidelity and Guaranty Company; and Hartford Accident and Indemnity Company, show cause why they should not be held in contempt of Court for the reasons set forth above, and a hearing shall be scheduled for November 13, 2019 at 9:00 am at the Richland County Judicial Center.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that service of this Rule to Show Cause shall be served upon the South Carolina Department of Insurance for Zurich American Insurance Company; Sentry Insurance, A Mutual Company; United States Fidelity and Guaranty Company; and Hartford Accident and Indemnity Company, at least ten days prior to the Rule to Show Cause Hearing, which shall constitute proper service pursuant to Rule 4(e) of the South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure.
