Dear Ms. Allen,

On September 25, 2019, I received a letter from Samuel Harms of Double Aught Injury Lawyers requesting the transcript on the above captioned case for hearings held on June 25, 2019, and January 24, 2019. I responded back to him on September 27th wanting confirmation that he represented one of the parties. I did not immediately hear back from him on that, and on September 30, 2019, I responded to his original letter with an estimated cost of the transcripts and instructions that I would need payment prior to placing the transcripts in line for production.

On October 8, 2019, I received an email from Michaela Horan, litigation paralegal with Double Aught Injury Lawyers, sending me a copy of an October 4, 2019, letter from the Court of Appeals stating that the order challenged on appeal might not be immediately appealable. I responded back to Ms. Horan telling her that I would archive her request in case the transcript is needed in the future.
