

## ORDER

First, the motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* is denied pursuant to *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995). The filing fee must be paid within fifteen days of the date of this order.

Second, the motion for the appointment of counsel is denied. *See Ex parte Dibble*, 279 S.C. 592, 594, 310 S.E.2d 440, 442 (Ct. App. 1983) (providing there is no right to the appointment of counsel in civil cases).
