To Daniel E. Shearouse, Clerk of Court South Carolina Supreme Court:

Subject: Johnnie Ann Carroll v. Brown and Brehmer, Case No. 2019-001892

After reading your letters and thoroughly reviewing South Carolina's Rules of Civil Procedure, I can see that you are completely disconnected from what the rules say, mean, intend , and create.

You stated that you were at a loss to understand why I believed this Original Jurisdiction Complaint was being handled as an Appeal, then proceeded to point out that we were proceeding under the Appellate Court Rules. On November 15th, 2019, you sent a letter to the Defendants in this case advising them that they need not answer and referring to them as "Respondents", an Appeals Court term. Everything that you have done indicates that this is being handled as an Appeal.

Additionally, there is no precedent or authority for the Clerk to advise Defendants that they need not answer. It is absolutely necessary that the Defendants answer, not only because that is the mandated procedure, but also because the Defendants are officers and employees of the Court. You have given the Defendants 3 months to destroy evidence, collaborate on their stories, intimidate witnesses, and fabricate excuses for their indefensible actions. You have interfered with this case, violated Plaintiff's Rights, and tilted this process in favor of the Defendants; therefore, I demand that you produce an Order signed by the Justices of the South Carolina Supreme Court stating that the Defendants do not have to answer or that you send a letter to the Defendants advising them of your error and requiring them to immediately answer this complaint.

You are already past due on correcting your error, so I will not accept any delay. If I do not have a response from you by February 29th, 2020, then I will add you and the Clerk's Office as Defendants on this Complaint.

You have obviously become accustomed to arbitrarily abusing the position and trust that you have been granted. I suggest you familiarize yourself with the Constitution of the United States, and the Justice System that it clearly lays out. You are not an arbiter of, authority on, or interpreter of Our Constitution. As soon as you became an employee of the Government, you became subject to every limitation, restriction, duty, obligation, and prohibition that Our Constitution lays on Federal, State, and Local Government. You may not exercise any action,

authority, or power that conflicts with the limitations and protections that Our Constitution imposes on all Government in these United States. Doing so indicates that you place yourself above Our Constitution, which is not acceptable.

I expect an answer from you and a correction of your errors by February 29th, 2020.
