Upon reviewing your appellant's initial brief and designation of matter, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- A proof of service has not been provided for the documents. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The content of your initial brief is not in compliance with Rule 208(b), SCACR. Specifically, the brief shall contain under appropriate headings and in the following order: table of contents and cases; statement of issues on appeal; statement of the case; standard of review; argument; and conclusion.

The documents that you submitted with your appellant's initial brief are being returned to you. These documents need to only be mentioned in the designation of matter and included in the record on appeal, pursuant to Rules 209 and 210, SCACR.
