This matter is before the court upon its own motion. This eviction action was originally tried by me on January 8, 2020. All parties appeared for a bench trial. After consideration of the pleadings, testimony, and other evidence presented, I ruled in favor of the respondent. On February 12, 2020, a bond hearing was conducted by Judge Lee A. Tindal to set an appeal bond in accordance with Sections 27-37-130 and 15-67-640 of the South Carolina Code. All parties also appeared for the bond hearing. The bond amount set by the court was Eight Thousand Five Hundred Eighty Three Dollars and 36 cents (\$8583.36). Judge Tindal also ordered court costs in addition to the bond. Her order states the bond be paid by February 18, 2020 pursuant to the appeal bond statute that requires the appellants to post bond within five days of the order. As of February 20, 2020, no bond has been posted with the court. As the aforementioned statutes require the trial magistrate to dismiss the appeal for failure to post bond, this appeal is dismissed with prejudice.
