Please note that the responsibility for insuring that information is redacted or sealed as required by this order rests with counsel and the parties. This office will not review filings for redaction or to determine if materials should be sealed.

Further, any request for an extension of time must comply with the requirements of this Court's order dated March 18, 2009 (available at www.sccourts.org/courtOrders/displayOrder.cfm?orderNo=2009-03-18-01)

For this matter to proceed, you will need to provide this Court with the date on which you received written notice of entry of the order dated October 3, 2019, denying the motion to reconsider. This order was apparently filed with the clerk of the circuit court on October 9, 2019. This requested information should be provided within ten (10) days of the date of this letter.

Finally, since you represent him in this case, no action will be taken on the *pro se* motion to reinstate. *Miller v. State*, 388 S.C. 347, 697 S.E.2d 527 (2010); *Jones v. State*, 348 S.C. 13, 558 S.E.2d 517 (2002); *State v. Stuckey*, 333 S.C. 56, 508 S.E.2d 564 (1998); *Foster v. State*, 298 S.C. 306, 379 S.E.2d 907 (1989).
