Dear Mr. Kuykendall:

Upon reviewing your amended appellant's initial brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected upon filing the appellant's final brief:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the title page shall only contain the case caption, the title of the case, the title of the document, and names and addresses of the counsel submitting the document. No other information shall be on the title page. Refer to the format shown by Form 13 in appendix C to part II of the SCACR. The title shall not contain any abbreviations and should read as follows:
Jack Kuykendall, #355988, Appellant,

v.

South Carolina Department of Corrections, Respondent.

- The content of the brief is not in compliance with Rule 208(b), SCACR. The brief of the appellant shall contain under appropriate headings and in the

following order: table of contents and cases; statement of issues on appeal; statement of the case; standard of review; argument; and conclusion.

- The document is improperly paginated. Specifically, the whole document needs to be consecutively numbered.
- The document has not been timely filed. A motion to allow the late filing will have to be made.

This is the Court's second request for these corrections. Failure to comply with the Court's request will result in the dismissal of this appeal.

The Court is in receipt of your designation of matter. The documents submitted with the designation of matter are being returned to you. These documents need to only be listed in the designation of matter and included in the record on appeal, pursuant to Rules 209 and 210, SCACR.
