Attention South Carolina Court of Appeals: I have recently received a letter dated Feb 6th, 2020 informing me that Mrs. Michana Tate (my trial lawyer) has been appointed by the Appeals court to represent me during my appeal. I believe that Mrs. Michana Tate was ineffective during my trial and I intend to present my proof to the Court of Appeals, therefore this is a non-conflicting matter. Mrs. Michana Tate also failed to inform me of and assist with my direct appeal process. When I asked about my direct appeal on Dec 20, 2019, she stated that I would have to contact her after Christmas, however she was well aware that I only had 10 days to file a direct appeal. I also received a letter from the Appeals Court dated Feb 6th, 2020 that I didn't receive until Feb, 10, 2020 stating that my proof of service document was not signed or dated and I have 10 days to correct this. These are errors

that wouldn't have been made if Mrs. Michana Tate would have assisted with my direct appeal in the beginning as required by SCACR. I have reasons to believe that Mrs. Michana Tate has motives to not represent me effectively, therefore I do not feel comfortable having her as my attorney. I am respectfully requesting that the Court of Appeals please relieve her as my counsel and appoint me another attorney.
