

ORDER

Petitioner asks this Court to recall the remittitur sent in this matter on June 4, 2019. Because we inadvertently failed to advise Petitioner of his right to file a *pro se* response to the petition for a writ of certiorari filed by his counsel pursuant to *Johnson v. State*, 294 S.C. 310, 364 S.E.2d 201 (1988), we grant the motion to recall the remittitur. *See State v. Keels*, 39 S.C. 553, 17 S.E. 802, 802 (1893) (requiring a very strong showing that the remittitur was sent down by mistake, error, or inadvertence of the Court to justify recalling the remittitur). Petitioner shall serve and file his *pro se* response within forty-five (45) days of the date of this order.
