
PERSONALLY APPEARED BEFORE ME Joette D. Scarborough, who being

first duly sworn, deposes and states:

1. I am over the age of eighteen (18), of sound mind and otherwise competent to make a statement under oath.
2. That I am employed by the South Carolina Department of Corrections (SCDC). I currently serve as Assistant Director of Institutional Classification.
3. That as part of my duties in my position as Assistant Director, I am responsible for developing, implementing and monitoring institutional classification policies and procedures regarding, job assignments, programs, earned work and education credits, and periodic reviews of inmates.

4. On or about August 27, 2012, I participated in a review of several documents from Mr. Ford's record. Following that review, it was determined that he was enrolled in SCDC's educational program from October, 1995 to April, 1996. However, Mr. Ford had not been given earned education credits for that time period.
5. As a result of this review, Mr. Ford's records were updated to reflect earned education credits for the period from October 1, 1995 to April 1, 1996.
6. After the additional credits were added Mr. Ford's projected maxout date changed from January 13, 2014 to December 17, 2013.

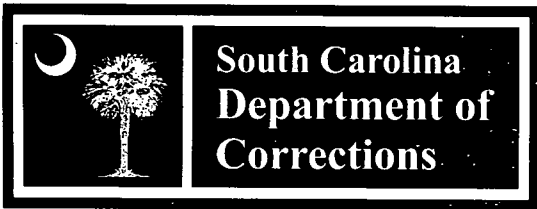
