
Counsel has filed a fourth request for an extension of time for his client to file a pro se guilty plea explanation. Counsel indicates a transcript has been ordered, but has not provided any proof of ordering the transcript in accordance with Rule 207 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. However, a transcript is not necessary for purposes of providing a written explanation showing that there is an issue that can be reviewed on appeal pursuant to Rule 203(d)(1)(B)(iv), SCACR. Accordingly, the request for an extension of time to file a pro se guilty plea explanation is denied. The appellant must provide a guilty plea explanation within 30 days of the date of this order or the Court will proceed with its consideration of the guilty plea explanation provided by counsel.
