MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Adrian Jenkins respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until April 6, 2020**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Adrian Jenkins respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of The State v. Jonathan Donell Rhodes with this Court on January 28, 2020. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of David G. Johnson v. The State with this Court on January 10, 2020. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Nikki Giovanni Echols with the Court of Appeals on January 2, 2020.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.


