I.

The Brief of Respondent in the above-referenced case is due to be served and filed on February 27, 2013.

II.

Pursuant to RE: Extension Requests in Criminal Direct Appeals and Post-Conviction Relief Certiorari Proceedings: Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009, the State moves for a third extension in the above-referenced criminal appeal. Due to work required in other cases pending before this Court and the South Carolina Court of Appeals, I am unable to complete this Brief on time. In the past few weeks, the undersigned has




