

**Motion for Extension of Time to File Return to
Appellant's Motion to Recall Remittitur**

Pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, Respondent South Carolina Department of Employment and Workforce (the Department) submits this motion to the Court requesting an extension of time to file Respondent's return to Appellant's motion to recall the remittitur. Currently, the Department's return is due March 9, 2020, and the Department requests an additional ten days to file its return. This is the Department's first request for an extension. The Department requests this extension due to the limited amount of time to file a return coupled with counsel's existing case load. Further, the Department does not believe this short extension would prejudice Appellant. Thus, the Department requests an extension of ten days to file its return to Appellant's



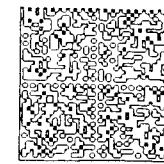

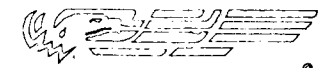
