**AMENDMENT TO REQUEST FOR REASONABLE ACCOMMODATION
RE INITIAL BRIEF AND DESIGNATION MATTER FILING DEADLINE
PURSUANT TO THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT**

Appellant respectfully amends his prior request for reasonable accommodation pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act seeking an extension of time required for Appellant to file his initial brief and designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal to March 2, 2020, a forty-five day extension. Appellant has diligently worked to prepare the initial brief and designation of matter within that time frame but due to his psychiatric disabilities has only been able to complete approximately 70% of the initial brief.¹ Accordingly, Appellant respectfully amends his prior accommodation request for extension by seeking an additional twenty days from March 2, 2020 to March 23, 2020, since March 22nd is a weekend day.

Appellant also respectfully submits this request for reasonable accommodation pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act regarding the filing deadline for Appellant's reply brief. Appellant respectfully requests the deadline be extended from ten days to thirty days due to Appellant's psychiatric disabilities.

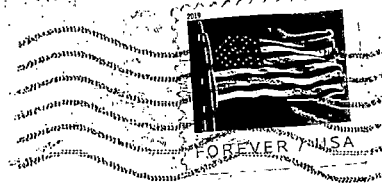
