MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Michael Orlando Brown respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Michael Orlando Brown respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the


number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

On February 21, 2020, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Jabriel Singleton v. The State with the Supreme Court. On February 12, 2020, counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Andre Heatley with the Court of Appeals. On February 3, 2020, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Gussie Henry Hilton v. The State with the Supreme Court. On January 31, 2020, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Robert McCaffrey with the Court of Appeals. On January 28, 2020, counsel, along with Victor Seeger, filed a petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in The State v. Jonathan Donell Rhodes with the Supreme Court. On January 23, 2020, counsel filed a petition for rehearing in The State v. Shane Alexander Washington with the Court of Appeals. On January 17, 2020, counsel, along Robert Dudek and David Alexander, filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Marion Lindsey v. The State with the Supreme Court. On January 15, 2020, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Marreese Jamaul Fripp with the Court of Appeals.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.




