

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Nicholas Benjamin Chhith-Berry in this Court on January 29, 2020. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Jamie Simpson in this Court on January 23, 2020. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Terriel Leshawn Mack in this Court on January 21, 2020.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay.


4. As indicated by his consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.


