**JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PETITION FOR REHEARING**

Respondents South Carolina Ports Authority (Ports Authority) and South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) (collectively Respondents) respectfully and jointly move the Court for a second extension of time to file a Petition for Rehearing pursuant to Rules 221(a), 240, and 263(b) SCACR. In support of this Motion, Respondents state as follows:

1. This Court filed a published opinion in the above-captioned matter, Opinion No. 27949, on February 19, 2020, reversing and remanding the matter to the Administrative Law Court.

2. On February 25, 2020, Respondents filed a motion for a 15-day extension of time to file a Petition for Rehearing, which the Court granted by Order dated February 26, 2020. Currently, a Petition for Rehearing is due to be filed on or before March 20, 2020.

3. In the intervening time period, unprecedented disruptions have occurred across all aspects of society as a result of the Covid-19 virus, including the South Carolina court system. These disruptions, along with other work obligations of counsel for Respondent, have caused a strain on the personal and work obligations of the Respondents, which have caused an impediment to counsel's ability to meaningfully comply with the current deadline. As a result, counsel for Respondents Ports Authority and DHEC respectfully jointly request a second extension of an additional fifteen (15) days to file respective Petitions for Rehearing.

4. If the Court grants this request, Counsel for the Respondents calculates that they will have until Monday, April 6, 2020, in which to file, if necessary, a Petition for Rehearing.


5. Counsel for the Respondents has consulted with Counsel for the Petitioners, and the undersigned is authorized to state that Petitioners consent to the granting of this request.




