Dear Mr. Spears:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the caption shall contain the name of the appellate court where the document is to be filed; the name of the county and judge from which the appeal is taken; the title of the case; the title of the document; and the name, address, and phone number of the counsel submitting the document.
- The form and content of the notice of appeal does not comply with Rule 203(e), SCACR. The only information that should be included in the notice of appeal are the following: name of the court, judge, and county from which the appeal is taken; the docket number of the case in the lower court; the date of the order or judgment from which the appeal is taken; a statement of when the appealing party received the notice of the order or judgment from which the appeal is taken; the name of the party taking the appeal; and the

names, mailing address, and telephone numbers of all attorneys of record and the name of the party or parties represented by each.
