Respondent's motion to dismiss this appeal is granted because the underlying order granting relief under Rule 60(b), SCRCF, is not immediately appealable pursuant to section 14-3-330 of the South Carolina Code (2017). See *Pocisk v. Sea Coast Const. of Beaufort*, 380 S.C. 584, 671 S.E.2d 98 (Ct. App. 2008) (holding the grant of a Rule 60(b) motion to set aside a consent judgment is not immediately appealable); *Pioneer Associates, Inc. v. Ticor Title Ins. Co.*, 300 S.C. 346, 387 S.E.2d 711 (Ct. App. 1989) (holding the grant of a Rule 60(b) motion to set aside a default judgment is not immediately appealable).
