request an extension of time to File and Serve their Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be

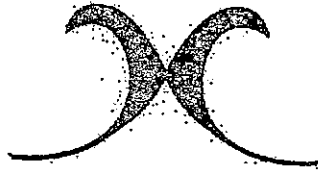

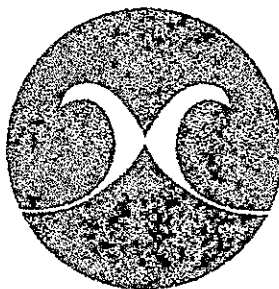
