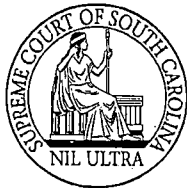
I feel my rights have been violated based on the facts of evidence in this case. Please read ALL paperwork. I am asking for a judgement in this court.

This responds to your letter dated March 2, 2020. Since you are asking for relief, this letter has been construed as a motion.

You have not provided a certificate or affidavit of service showing that a copy of this motion has been served on the opposing party as required by Rule 240(c)(1) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). *See also* Rule 262(b), SCACR ("Whenever under these Rules service is required or permitted to be made upon a party represented by an attorney the service shall be made upon the attorney unless service upon the party himself is ordered by the appellate court.").

Further, since this appeal is pending before the South Carolina Court of Appeals, any request for relief will mostly likely need to be made to that Court rather than to this Court.<sup>1</sup> Rule 245, SCACR (as a general rule, relief must be sought in the

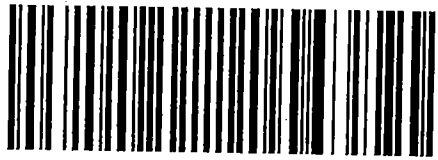

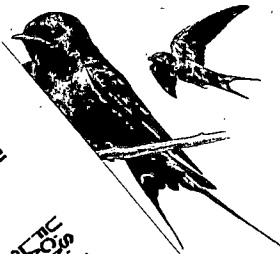
