ORDER

The appeal in this matter was dismissed by the South Carolina Court of Appeals.¹ Petitioner has now filed a notice of appeal seeking review of that dismissal.

Under Rule 242 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), decisions of the Court of Appeals are reviewed by serving and filing a petition for a writ of certiorari and an appendix. The notice of appeal that petitioner has filed does not have the content required for either a petition or an appendix under that rule. Rule 242 (d) and (e), SCACR.

Further, petitioner has not provided a proof of service showing that the document he has filed has been served on opposing counsel. Rule 242(c), SCACR (requiring petition to be accompanied by a proof of service showing it has been served on opposing counsel). Finally, petitioner has neither paid the filing fee required by Rule 242(c), SCACR, nor filed a motion seeking permission of this Court to proceed without paying that filing fee.


Accordingly, the notice of appeal filed with this Court is dismissed. Rule 260,
