

I'm in receipt of your order dated March 27, 2020, in which I received on the 31st. As such, please be advise that I have not and did not filed a notice of appeal on the 21st of February, 2020, as indicated in your order in the aforementioned case. Your findings will show that there is no appealable order from the Respondent SCDPPPS, nor is there an appeal on the ALC authorize form. Your findings will show a notice for writ of mandamus and my motion for a writ of mandamus, not a notice of appeal.


Your order indicates that the court will address the appeal separately. Again, there is no appeal in this matter. My request for the writ of mandamus came before this court when the Respondent failed to redress my reply for the following request:

1. The Vote count from my 2010 and 2012 parole hearings;
2. The parole members names who were present and entered their votes, and whether to grant or deny parole; and alternative,
3. The conditions setforth to meet, and if I did meet parole board members may decide that he should be granted parole within 30 days of the date of his request, or if he fail to complete any one of the stated conditions setforth by the parole board members or disobey any rule or regulation of SCDC before satisfying the stated conditions, the parole board may reject for parole in accordance to its own criteria.

Please, if you may, send me a copy of the notice of appeal with me signature and the date on the same to me and the court of appeals at your earliest convenience in an effort to resolve this matter regarding the same, because your findings will show that there is no notice of appeal before this court pertaining to this matter.



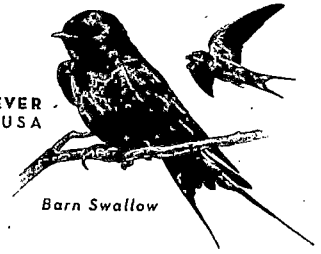

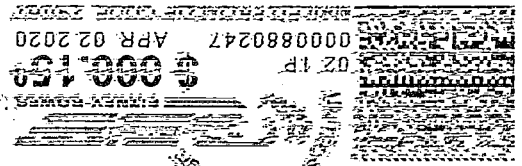
