The Appellant is in objection of the Administrative Law Court's final order filed on Dec. 04, 2019, concerning case no. 19-ALJ-15-0033-AP. The Administrative Law Court admitted its inability to review the full scope of SCDPPP's decision making process. A process that does full under S.C. Codes of law §24-22-30 and SCDC policy PS 10.17 signed into law. On 5/21/18 this policy was in fact abrogated to fit new agency standard updates. 


