Dear Ms. Kitchings:

On March 30, 2020, Respondents filed a Joint Motion to Require Appellant to File and Serve an Amended Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. Appellant recently filed an Amended Designation of Matter. Accordingly, by this letter, Respondents withdraw their Joint Motion filed March 30, 2020.

The Certificate of Service accompanying Appellant's Amended Designation provided that it was mailed on March 31, 2020. However, the postmark on the envelopes sent to Respondents was April 6, 2020 and the documents were not actually received by Respondents until April 8, 2020. Thus, Respondents have recalculated the deadline for their respective initial briefs based upon the date Appellant's Amended Designation was actually mailed. Typically then, our briefs would be due on May 6, 2020. However, in light of the Supreme Court's Order on the Operation of the Appellate Courts During the Coronavirus Emergency, all appellate filing deadlines are extended for twenty days. (See Mar. 20, 2020 Order, section (1)(1)). Accordingly, Respondents are calendaring the deadline for their initial briefs for May 26, 2020. If the Court calculates a different filing deadline, please let us know. **Otherwise, Respondents will plan to file their respective initial briefs or any motions for extension of time on or before May 26, 2020.**

Respondents understand that the Court has served a deficiency letter to Appellant regarding the caption on her Initial Brief of Appellant. However, the correction of the case caption only on Appellant's brief should not impact Respondents' ability to prepare their respective briefs and has not been factored into the above calculations.
