Dear Ms. LaPrade:

Upon further review of your documents filed on March 19, 2020, which this Court construes as a notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this appeal will be dismissed:

- The notice of appeal must be substantially in the format shown by Form 1 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The notice of appeal must include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which this appeal is taken.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$250.00.
- A copy of the order being challenged on appeal must be provided.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service showing that a copy of the notice of appeal has been timely served on the respondent(s) and the lower court that is substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.

- Please be advised that the documents and argument provided with your filings are not needed at this time. Therefore, no further action will be taken on them. If you wish to request relief from this Court in any way, you must do so in the form of a motion pursuant to Rule 240 of the SCACR.
