To Whom it May Concern:

This firm represents Respondent Nationstar Mortgage, LLC in Appellate Case No. 2019-001732. On Friday, April 24, 2020, it appears the Court sent a letter to our attention that states that Respondent's deadline for filing its initial brief and designation of matter has expired. There are two issues I wanted to address with the hopes of getting a resolution and to figure out what else we need to provide to the Court.

First, Appellants served their initial brief on Respondents on March 9, 2020 and filed it thereafter on March 10, 2020. Accordingly, Respondents had 30 days to file its initial brief and designation of matter on appeal, which would have been April 8, 2020. However, according to the Supreme Court's Order, dated March 20, 2020 (Order No. 2020-03-20-01), the due dates for all Appellate Court filings due on or after the effective date of the order were extended for twenty (20) days. Thus, the new deadline for Respondents to file its Initial Brief was extended to April 28, 2020.

In addition, on Tuesday, April 21, 2020, Respondents sent via US Mail Priority its motion for an extension of time to file its initial brief. I have attached a copy of the filings, as well as the envelope evidencing mailing. We understand that there is a 48 hour quarantine period for documents received by mail and anticipate that the Court will be reviewing this filing today and backdating the filing to the date of delivery. This filing has been served on Appellants' counsel via email per the terms of the previously aforementioned Supreme Court order.

Please give me a call at your earliest convenience to discuss this matter in more detail as we want to make sure we are properly following the Court's guidance in these uncertain times. Out of an abundance of caution, we will be faxing over the filing this afternoon as well.
