Ladies and Gentleman:

I am writing to confirm my understanding of the deadlines in the above case in light of the Supreme Court's recent order regarding appellate court operations due to the COVID-19 crisis. That order extends all deadlines in appellate cases by twenty days (except the notice-of-appeal deadline).


Accordingly, my understanding is that the initial brief and designation of matter will be due twenty days after the previous due date of April 20, which I calculate to be May 11, 2020. Respondents' Brief would be due fifty days after service of my brief, and my reply brief would be

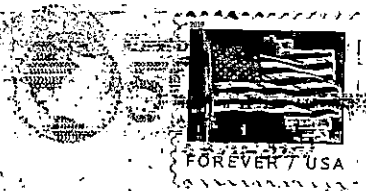
