NOTICE OF APPEAL

Alan Nix appeals five orders of the Honorable Derham Cole, Maite Murphy and Earhart Overstreet in the above cited case. Appellants received written notice of the entry of the order denying Plaintiff's Motion 59 on 19 March 2010. At the time of the Notice of Appeal, there are still three motions of Plaintiff which have not been ruled on. One from December 2019, one from February 2020 and one from March 2020. Given Appellant has been witness to / victim of multiple different acts of intentional judicial corruption dating back several years, Plaintiff / Appellant assumes this is another intentional act of judicial corruption intended to deceive

Plaintiff / Appellant and therefore, out of an abundance of caution, is submitting this Notice of Appeal at this time to eliminate any possible additional acts of improper judicial trickery / deception being used to further subvert the Rule of Law.

Consequently, this Notice of Appeal should also be construed as a Motion to remand the case back to the lower court to have the three outstanding motion properly filed and ruled upon before any Appeal process actually commences.

Appellant also wants to ensure this Court is not confused by the fifth order being appealed, specifically the one included as Exhibit E, with a file stamp of 27 September 2019, signed by Judge Murphy on 20 September 2019 and entitled "*ORDER ENJOINING THE PLAINTIFF FROM RE-FILING THIS MATTER AND IMPOSING SANCTIONS UPON THE PLAINTIFF*". Clearly the case number of this order is not 2019-CP-10-01496, but the SC Judicial System's agent, Charleston County, which runs this State's District Court in Charleston, SC, has cited this order not once, not twice, not three times; but four times since December 2019 as the reason they have refused to file orders of the Plaintiff / Appellant in this case, 2019-CP-10-01496. Their canned response reads "*Unable to file pursuant to Judge Murphy's order dated 9/27/19*". Given the Plaintiff / Appellant views this conduct as clear, knowing, and willful obstruction of justice, not substantially unlike this Court's own conduct in appeals 2018-000056 and 2018-000178, and it was created by this Court's own attorney, citing clearly and easily known untruths, clearly this Court, along with its attorney(s) and agents are involved in a relatively serious legal issue.

The five orders being appealed at this time are:

1. Order dated and filed 5 February 2020 granting motion to dismiss (Ex. A)
2. Proposed order filed 6 February 2020 entitled "*Order Granting Motion to Dismiss*". (Ex. B). (For reasons not completely known, the Charleston County Clerk of Court has not posted a copy of this order on their website as of the date of this Notice of Appeal. However, upon information and belief, it is the same order that is contained in Ex. C)
3. Order dated and filed 14 February 2020, entitled "*Order Granting Motion to Dismiss*". (Ex C)

4. Order dated 10 March 2020, filed 12 March 2020 denying Plaintiff's second Rule 59 motion. (Ex. D)
5. Order from case 2018-CP-10-03315 dated 20 Sept 2019, filed 27 Sept 2019, entitled "*ORDER ENJOINING THE PLAINTIFF FROM RE-FILING THIS MATTER AND IMPOSING SANCTIONS UPON THE PLAINTIFF*" Judge Murphy's order that Charleston County and others have improperly utilized in this case, as well as others, to obstruct justice, among other improper conduct.

This Notice of Appeal is being filed on 17 April 2020 to ensure a timely appeal is filed and no South Carolina Judicial system trickery is allowed to be improperly introduced into this matter. However, Appellant / Plaintiff still requires the outstanding motions to be ruled upon and requests leave to file those orders under this appeal once available.


