

ORDER

This appeal was dismissed on May 21, 2019, and Appellant's petition for rehearing was denied on November 14, 2019. This Court sent down the remittitur on December 30, 2019. Appellant has now filed a motion to recall the remittitur. A remittitur cannot be recalled except upon "a very strong showing . . . that remittitur was sent down through some mistake or inadvertence on the part of this Court or its officer." *State v. Keels*, 39 S.C. 553, 17 S.E. 802 (1893). Appellant has failed to make such a showing. Because remittitur was properly sent, this Court no longer has jurisdiction over the case. Appellant's motion to recall remittitur, therefore, is denied.
