Pursuant to your letter dated January 25, 2013, I am writing to provide you with an update of the pending settlement agreement. Appellants have consulted with its MSA vendor, which, in turn has contacted CMS to determine whether a Medicare Set Aside Agreement is necessary to resolve this case. I have just been apprised that a Medicare Set Aside Agreement is not necessary with respect to resolving this case. To this end, I am in the process of drafting a Settlement Agreement, Release and Order. I anticipate forwarding the proposed Settlement Agreement and Release to Respondent's counsel no later than Friday, March 1, 2013.

Accordingly, I would expect that within thirty (30) days, the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission will have received the proposed Settlement Agreement. Once the Commission has approved and filed the Settlement Agreement and Release, I shall contact the Court advising that all settlement documents have been received by the Commission and that the Court can return the file.


