MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Pursuant to Rules 208 and 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules and the Order issued by the Supreme Court of South Carolina on March 20, 2020, regarding Operation of the Appellate Courts During the Coronavirus Emergency, Appellant, through her undersigned Counsel, hereby moves this Court for an Order granting an extension of time to file and serve the Appellant’s Record on Appeal in the above-captioned action.

Appellant filed her Initial Brief and Designation of Matter on January 21, 2020. Respondents’ Initial Briefs and Designations of Matter were due on February 20, 2020. Currently, Appellant’s Record on Appeal was due on or about March 21, 2020. Pursuant to the Supreme Court’s Order dated March 20, 2020, “the due dates for all Appellate Court filings due on or about the effective date of this order are hereby extended twenty (20) days.” This Order thus allows

Appellant to file her Record on Appeal on or about April 10, 2020. On April 1, 2020, Appellant filed her first Motion for Extension of Time, due to circumstances surrounding the health of Co-Counsel Glenn E. Bowens, Esquire, and the coronavirus situation. This Court granted the Appellant's Motion, allowing her to file her Record on Appeal on May 11, 2020.

Unfortunately, Glenn E. Bowens, Esquire, was recently hospitalized again for health issues unrelated to the coronavirus. Due to the second hospitalization of Attorney Bowens and the current pandemic, the undersigned party requests an extension of time of an additional thirty (30) days to file and serve their Record on Appeal. If the Motion for Extension is granted as proposed, the new deadline for the Appellant's Record on Appeal is Wednesday, June 10, 2020. This is Appellant's second request for an extension of this deadline.




