Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter:

The Notice of Appeal fails to specify when written notice of entry of the order from which the appeal is taken was received. *See* Rule 203(b)(1) (providing that a notice of appeal from the court of common pleas "shall be served on all respondents within thirty (30) days after receipt of written notice of entry of the order or judgment"); Rule 203(e)(1)(C), SCACR ("if appropriate for the determination of the timeliness of the appeal, a statement of when the appealing party received notice of the order or judgment from which the appeal is taken" shall be included in the notice of appeal).
