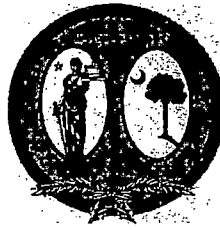

I have received your letter dated 12-21-2019. In it, you ask about why I filed an appeal on your behalf. I did so because you wrote to me on 10-11-2019 requesting an appeal. I filed the appeal based on that letter. While your appeal was definitely within the 10 day window provided by the rules, I did not receive your letter until after the 10 day window to appeal was expired. I filed your appeal and a motion to allow your appeal to go forward as I wasn't able to file it before your time was expired. The Court of Appeals granted my motion and allowed your appeal to go forward. 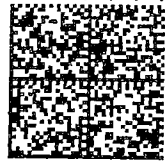
