As counsel for the Respondent South Carolina Community Bank, we respectfully request a 30-day extension of time in which to serve and file our Initial Respondent's Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal. The Brief and Designations are currently due on Monday, May 11, 2020 pursuant to Section (l)(1) of this Court's Order dated March 20, 2020.
